Failure to provide care for an unaccompanied foreign minor, aged 12, in the 'lande de Calais' shanty town was in breach of the Convention
In today's Chamber judgment¹
in the case of Khan v. France (application no. 12267/16) the European Court of Human Rights held, unanimously, that there had been: a violation of Article 3 (prohibition of inhuman and degrading treatment) of the European Convention on Human Rights.

Unaccompanied alien minors detained in degrading conditions in Greek police stations: a number of violations
The case concerned the placement of nine migrants, unaccompanied minors, in different police stations in Greece, for periods ranging between 21 and 33 days. The migrants were subsequently transferred to the Diavata reception centre and then to special facilities for minors.
In today's Chamber judgment¹
in the case of H.A. and Others v. Greece (application no. 19951/16) the European Court of Human Rights held, unanimously, that there had been: a violation of Article 3 (prohibition of inhuman or degrading treatment) of the European Convention on Human Rights on account of the conditions of the applicants' detention in the police stations; no violation of Article 3 as regards the living conditions in the Diavata centre; a violation of Article 13 (right to an effective remedy) taken together with Article 3; a violation of Article 5 §§ 1 and 4 (right to liberty and security of person).

in the case of *Beghal v. the United Kingdom* (application
